The National Diving & Activity Centre is promoting a Sponsored ZipWire fundraising event for SARA on Saturday/Sunday 14/15<sup>th</sup> April 2012 at the National Diving & Activity Centre, Chepstow.

The ZipWire will run 720m across the quarry and will be the LONGEST ZIP WIRE in the UK. One participant will be the first to ride it and all participants have the opportunity to qualify for a thrilling trip aboard the fast inshore lifeboat SARA 1.



This event is being promoted by The National Diving & Activity Centre for the purpose of raising funds for SARA. Registration Fee of £20 is required and a pledge to raise a minimum of £50 sponsorship for SARA is required (registration Fee can be recovered from sponsorship)

**Prior to the event:-**

1. Entry forms to take part can be obtained by contacting [d.thompson@sara-rescue.org.uk](mailto:d.thompson@sara-rescue.org.uk) Mob: 07725744636 or [E.Hardie@sara-rescue.org.uk](mailto:E.Hardie@sara-rescue.org.uk) Mob: 0773 4657070. Please indicate a preferred time for your Zip Wire. The event will begin at 09:00 and finish at 13:00. Zip Wire times will be staggered throughout the event.
2. Please forward your entry form and deposit of £20.00 (this can be taken out of any additional sponsorship money that you raise) by way of a cheque made payable to SARA quoting your name and postcode on the back of the cheque. SEND TO: SARA Zip Wire Coordinator, The Lifeboat Station, Beachley, Chepstow, NP16 7HH
3. Upon receipt, we will provide you with a sponsor form and information pack, Zip Wire times will be allocated nearer the event.
4. In order to take part, you pledge to raise a minimum total of £50 including your £20 deposit. This additional sum (at least £30.00) must be received by SARA two weeks before the event or sponsorship to this value paid through a Justgiving account to SARA. The highest fundraiser on Justgiving (online and mobile donations only) will win the "Golden ticket" to be the first to ride the Longest Zip Wire in the UK. All individuals raising £100 or more will be entered in the boat trip draw **with the individual raising the highest amount of sponsorship automatically qualifying.**
5. To take part in the Zip Wire, you must under 20 stone in weight and be at least 11 years of age. (Under 18's will need to produce a signed 'Under 18' Parental Consent Form – please request this at time of booking) **NB The parent or legally appointed guardian will need to be present at the top of the Zip Wire.**
6. Insurance - the event organiser, The National Diving & Activity Centre, has arranged all insurances. Should you wish to discuss this, please contact them directly on 01291 630850
7. If you are suffering from a medical condition, disability or have any reason to doubt your fitness to participate, we advise you to consult your doctor beforehand and discuss with our event organiser. In addition, we request that anyone suffering from a medical condition or disability, produces a doctors note confirming that they are fit enough to take part in the Zip Wire. All participants will be asked to sign a disclaimer.

**On the day:-**

1. For directions and details of the event location please visit <http://www.ndac.co.uk> Car parking is available at the Dive Centre which will be clearly identified.
2. Please proceed to the SARA Check-In Desk where you will be asked to complete a disclaimer.
3. Please bring your sponsor form along together with all monies raised to date.
4. Wear comfortable, warm clothing and sensible shoes. Baggy or loose clothing should not be worn and long hair should be tied back.
5. Following successful completion of your Zip Wire, please return to the Check-In Desk where you will be issued with a certificate confirming that you have successfully completed the Zip Wire.
6. Spectators are welcome but will not be allowed at the start of the Zip Wire location.
